Healthy Montcalm seeks community input

Stanton- Montcalm County residents will have the opportunity to share their opinions on local health matters in a survey being mailed on Saturday, August 20 by the Mid-Michigan District Health Department (MMDHD) to 1,500 random households.

The health department, in conjunction with Healthy Montcalm, a collaboration of local health, education, business, and human service organizations, is collecting the data in order to identify unmet health needs in the county. With this information, strategies will be developed to improve opportunities for family and community health.

Residents who receive the survey in the mail will have the choice of filling out the paper survey or completing the survey online. Those who submit a completed survey by September 9, 2011 will be entered in a drawing to win a gift card.

“This is an exciting opportunity to gather the opinions of Montcalm County residents as to what their health needs are and to determine the direction Healthy Montcalm should take in helping them lead healthier, more active lives,” said MMDHD Health Officer, Kimberly Singh.
