Mid-Michigan District Health Department cautions residents about individuals posing as Health Department Employees

Ithaca/Stanton/St. Johns~ The Mid-Michigan District Health Department (MMDHD) has received several calls from Sheridan area residents who have been visited by individuals claiming to represent “the Health Agency.” These individuals arrive unannounced, telling homeowners that they are required by law to have their water tested.

MMDHD would like all Clinton, Gratiot and Montcalm County residents to know that:

- The individuals in question do not represent MMDHD.
- MMDHD is not currently going door to door testing existing water well quality.
- Residents with existing water wells are not required to have their water tested by any state or federal law.
- All newly constructed water wells DO need to be tested by a MMDHD Environmental Health Specialist, but it is the homeowner’s responsibility to make the appointment.
- All testing conducted by MMDHD is by appointment only.
- When MMDHD personnel do test residential water wells they do so during normal business hours (8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m.). They also identify themselves as MMDHD employees and display their MMDHD photo identification badge.
