Household hazardous waste collection date set

Stanton- Montcalm County will be holding a household hazardous waste collection from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on June 2, 2018 at the Mid-Michigan District Health Department, which is located at 615 N. State Street, Stanton.

Accepted items: aerosols, automobile liquids, batteries, cleaning products, corrosives (acids and bases) fertilizers, fire extinguishers, flammable liquids, fluorescent bulbs, herbicides and pesticides, inert cylinders, mercury, oil-based paint (no latex), pesticides, pharmaceuticals/over-the-counter medications (non DEA), propane cylinders less than 30 pounds each, reactives and oxidizers, sharps (biomedical), solvents, smoke detectors, thermometers and tires up to 18" (\$2 each).

Electronic waste will also be accepted. Servers, laptops and towers will be free-of-charge. All other electronics will be \$.25 per pound.

Items not accepted: air conditioners, ammunition or weapons, asbestos, car parts, commercially-generated waste, construction materials/debris, explosives, flares, household trash, infectious medical waste, latex paint, radioactive materials, refrigerators or other large appliances, used vehicles and yard waste.

Volunteers are needed to assist with the hazardous waste collection. If you are interested in volunteering, or have questions about acceptable items, please call 989-831-3602.
