Those with unwanted, unneeded or expired prescriptions and over-the-counter medications are encouraged to take advantage of this free, no questions asked service.

Those dropping off medications may blacken out their name on bottles for added privacy, but it is not required. Bottles containing liquids should be placed in a ziploc bag. Sharps will not be accepted.
