Residential water sampling will now cost less

Ithaca, Stanton, St. Johns- Residents of Clinton, Gratiot and Montcalm Counties wanting to have their water tested can expect to pay a little less than before.

In the past, residents were required to mail water samples overnight to the State of Michigan's lab at a cost of \$21.

In an effort to lower the shipping cost, Mid-Michigan District Health Department has partnered with Kent County Health Department's Laboratory Services to pick up and transport water samples to its lab in Grand Rapids for testing.

Under the new arrangement, residents will drop water samples off at the Mid-Michigan District Health Department where they will await transport to the lab in Grand Rapids. The new shipping cost is just \$5.

The cost of the actual water test is between \$16 and \$36, depending on what type of test is needed.

Residents who would like to have their water tested can pick up sample bottles and testing instructions at the Environmental Health Division of the Mid-Michigan District Health Department, located at:
