E-Waste recycling available in Montcalm County

Stanton- Do you have a drawer, closet, or corner of your garage piled high with outdated, unused or broken electronics? Does that pile keep growing because you just don't know what to do with it?

Well, fret no more because a new program is now available that will help Montcalm area residents and businesses get rid of all that e-waste for good.

Montcalm County's Resource Recovery Coordinator has partnered with Comprenew, a Grand Rapids-based nonprofit electronics recycler to collect and recycle, refurbish or reuse e-waste, rather than placing it in landfills, where harmful toxins can leak into the soil and water.

This service will be available on Tuesdays and Thursdays by appointment only at the Mid-Michigan District Health Department, located at 615 N. State Street, Stanton.

Accepted items include cell phones, radios, microwaves, VCRs, TVs (\$.25/pound fee will apply to each cathode ray tube TV), laptops, monitors, keyboards, mice, printers, speakers, and power cords. Almost anything with a cord or battery is accepted. Please, no big box appliances, air conditioners or refrigerators.

It's important to note that Comprenew will destroy all computer hard drives. They do not ship e-waste overseas, and their zero-landfill policy requires all the e-waste received to be recycled, refurbished or reused.
