Household hazardous waste collection

Stanton- Montcalm County's yearly household hazardous waste collection event is set for June 13, 2015 at the Montcalm Area Career Center, which is located at 1550 W. Sidney Road, Sidney.

Accepted items: aerosols, auto liquids (antifreeze and oil), automobile tires (\$1 each), batteries, cell phones, cleaning products, corrosives (acids and bases) DVDs, VHS, floppy disks, electronics (computers, monitors, and TVs), fertilizers, fire extinguishers, flammable liquids, fluorescent bulbs, herbicides and pesticides, inert cylinders, latex and oil-based paint, mercury, pesticides, pharmaceuticals/over-the-counter medications (non DEA), propane cylinders less than 30 pounds each, reactives and oxidizers, sharps (biomedical), solvents, smoke detectors, and thermometers.

TVs and monitors with leaded glass will be accepted for a fee, which is based on screen size.

Items not accepted: tractor or airplane tires, refrigerators or other large appliances, ammunition or weapons, explosives, flares, asbestos, commercially-generated waste, construction materials/debris, car parts, air conditioners, radioactive materials, household trash, used vehicles, infectious medical waste, and yard waste.
