Employees from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency will be in St. Louis today to update the public about its cleanup of the former Velsicol Chemical Corporation plant site.

The sessions are today from 2-4 p.m. and 5-7 p.m. in the community room at city hall at 300 N. Mill Street, according to a news release.

Officials will be able to answer questions about the project's progress and demonstrate how to find data on its new, interactive webpage unveiled last month tracking the cleanup.

The EPA, working with the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality, continues investigation and cleanup at the superfund site.
