Head Start Open Enrollment

Stanton- Montcalm County parents who would like to enroll their child in Head Start are invited to attend an open enrollment and health services event on June 24.

The event will be held from 10:00 a.m. to noon and 12:30 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. at the Mid-Michigan District Health Department, located at 615 N. State Street in Stanton. Families are encouraged to apply online prior to the event. Applications for local preschool opportunities, as well as Early Head Start, are found at www.eightcap.org/earlychildhood.

At the event, parents can enroll their child in Head Start; enroll in the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) program; get their child's immunizations updated, and have their child's blood lead and hemoglobin tested.

Parents are asked to bring their driver's license, proof of income for the last 12 months (required for Head Start enrollment), their child's birth certificate, and insurance card.
