Dear Mr. Holt:

Pursuant to the Appeals Hearing held on February 5, 2020, the Mid-Michigan District Board of Appeals has determined that testing of the onsite drinking water well is required before a decision can be rendered. Notwithstanding this decision, issuance of a variance for the septic permit referenced above is still pending based upon the following:

1. Analysis of the drinking water well for bacteriological and partial chemistry testing
2. If contamination is found, the ability to remediate the well so that an acceptable drinking water sample is obtained.
3. Final decision from the Board of Appeals.

It is the understanding of the Board that you will conduct testing of the well. Once the results have been obtained and analyzed by the Board of Appeals, your request for a variance would be considered with the final decision of the Board of Appeals delivered to you via email at kevin.holt@ceddealer.com.
