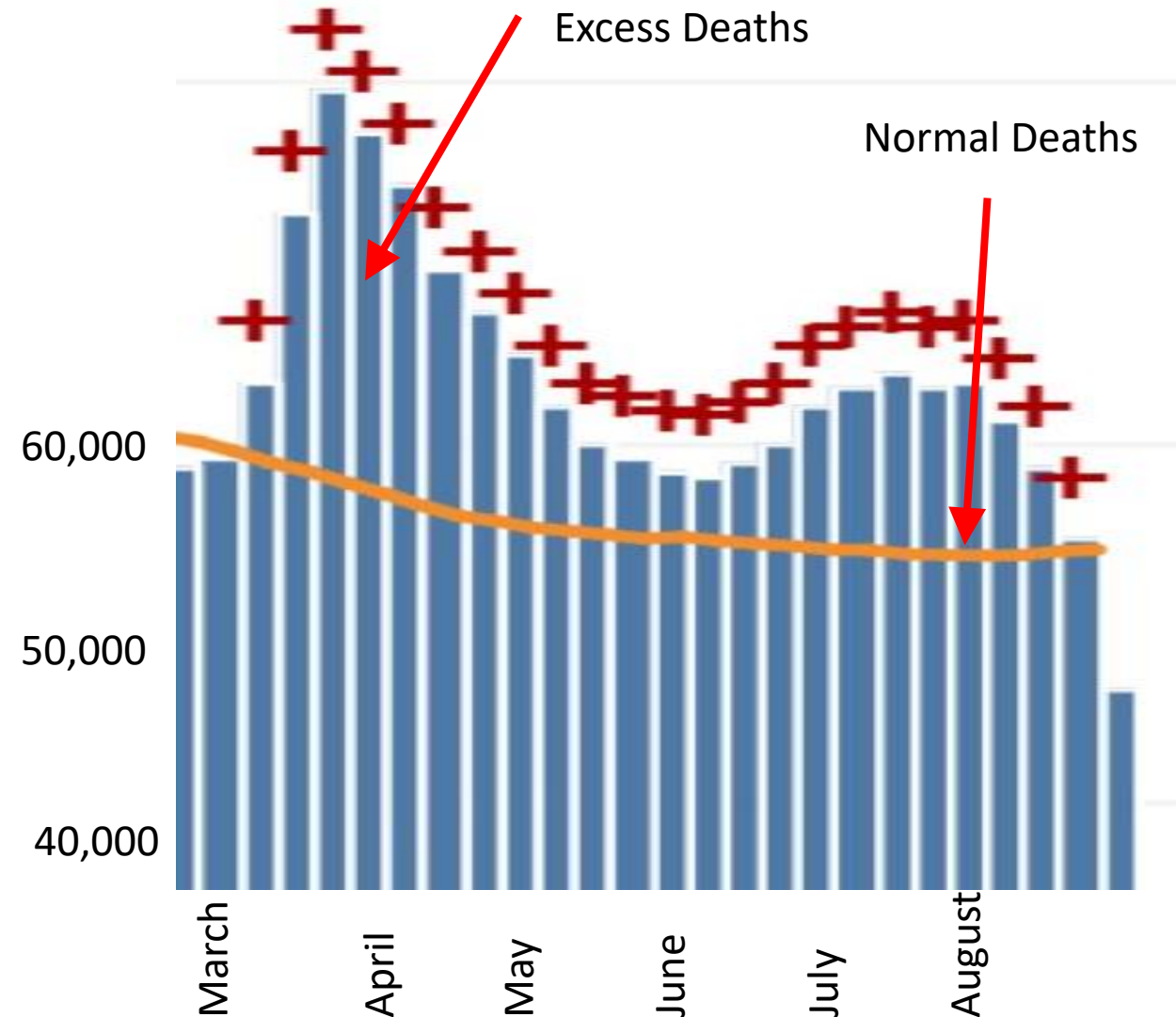


## US Deaths 21 Percent Higher Than Normal April - August

There were 1,360,338 deaths from March 28 through August 15. But only 1,123,837 deaths would have been expected in a normal year. That means there was 21% excess mortality during this time, a strong indication that COVID has killed many people directly or indirectly.
