Mid-Michigan District Health Department has an opening for a **full-time Registered Dietitian** to provide public health services based on the core competency and essential functions of public health. This position's base will be in the **Gratiot Branch Office** in Ithaca and will be expected to work district-wide. This position will work under the supervision of the Community Health and Education Division.

General Description of Responsibilities:

The registered dietitian (RD) is responsible for providing the nutrition component of agency services and health programs. They exercise a considerable degree of independent and professional judgment in planning for and implementing public health nutrition services in the district. RD's are expected to be able to assume leadership roles and may be responsible for some coordination and review of work performed by other professional staff and public health representatives. RD's must exercise considerable skill in working with clients and their families, other employees and the public; understand traditional public health activities; and, understand chronic disease control and prevention through risk reduction.

Qualifications:

- Bachelor of Science degree in Dietetics/Human Nutrition or related field and certification as a Registered Dietitian (RD) is required.
- Possession of a valid Michigan vehicle operator's license, own transportation and ability to travel as required.
- Physical Requirements:
 - Climbing, balancing, stooping, kneeling, crouching, reaching, standing, walking, lifting, and writing and repetitive motions.
 - Exert up to 50 pounds of force occasionally, and/or a negligible amount of force constantly to move objects.

Knowledge/Skills and Examples of Work:

- Knowledge of the core functions and essential services of public health.
- Excellent customer service skills.
- Considerable knowledge of the principles and practices of human nutrition.
- Considerable knowledge of the dietary control of diseases.
- Basic knowledge of the principles of health education.
- Ability to deliver education and consultation on nutrition to diverse groups.
- Ability to work with community groups and organizations.
