Hybrid TB Testing Workshop: This is a 2-part course, and you must complete both parts to get your certificate:

- Online portion: is on MI-TRAIN you will receive more information upon registration both on the screen and in an email NOTE: The MI-TRAIN portion will take about 3.25 hours

- In Person Practicum: You will learn to administer and read the tuberculin skin test, this takes about 1 hour

NOTE: Participants will need to bring a certificate of completion of the online portion to the in-person practicum and present to the instructor.

DO NOT complete the online workshop more than two weeks ahead of your in-person practicum. You should register for your practicum before completing the online workshop to ensure you are not completing the online workshop too early.

In order to be eligible for TST certification you must:

- Be a healthcare worker who has experience with injections, universal precautions, sterile technique, and be responsible for assessing risk of TB at your facility.
- Have at least one of the following credentials issued from an accredited institution: MD, DO, DDS, PharmBS, RPh, NP, PA, RN, BSN, MSN, LPN, EMT, EMP-P, CPhT, RMA, and CMA.
