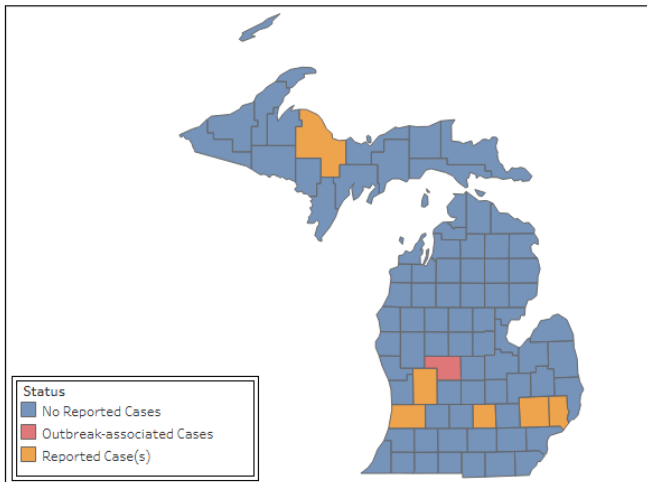

# 2024-2025 Community Health Assessments

Identified priority areas based on local data and community input

## Clinton County

### Access to Care

There is one healthcare provider for every **3,309** residents, a ratio more than **2.5** times higher than the state average.

### Behavioral Health

#### Substance Use Rates:

Binge Drinking: **9.5%**

Cannabis Use: **9.6%**

Cigarette Use: **11.0%**

E-Cigarette Use: **6.8%**

**5.7%** of adults reported poor mental health on average from 2020-2022.

### Housing

**34.2%** of households live below the ALICE threshold.

Asset Limited Income Constrained represents people who have jobs and earn money, but still struggle to afford basic needs, such as housing, food, and healthcare.

## Gratiot County

### Behavioral Health

There is one mental health care provider for every **430** residents, a ratio more than **1.5** times higher than the state average.

### Access to Health

There is one healthcare provider for every **2,080** residents, a ratio nearly **2** times more than the state average.

**15%** of adults consider themselves in fair or poor health

### Chronic Disease Prevention

**11%** of adults report having frequent physical distress.

**36%** of adults report being obese.

**10%** of adults report having diabetes

## Montcalm County

### Access to Care and Social Services

**6.5%** of residents do not have health insurance.

### Financial Security

The top reported factor impacting the health of survey respondents was **Financial Concerns**.

### Substance Use

There were **21.5** opioid poisoning deaths per 100,000 residents in 2022, a **50% increase** from 2021. In Montcalm County, this rate corresponds to approximately **14** deaths.

### Mental Health

**25%** of survey respondents went without needed mental health care in the past year.
